Extensive discussion ensued. Through the Strategic Planning Work Session dialogue, the Board of Supervisors reached a consensus on the following Strategic Priorities:

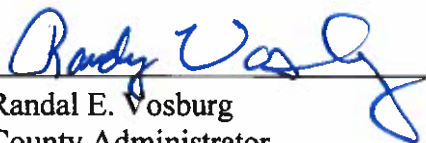

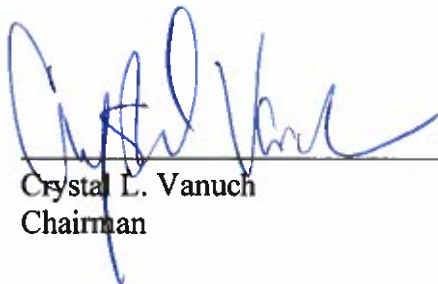
The Board concluded the Strategic Planning Work Session by speaking about the tremendous significance of identifying their Strategic Priorities and that they were determined through a process of compromise.
